Dr Maki-Petaja is a research associate at the Division of experimental medicine and immunotherapeutics at the University of Cambridge. She undertook her PhD under the supervision of Professors Ian Wilkinson at the University of Cambridge investigating aortic stiffness in patients with rheumatoid arthritis and was awarded her PhD in 2008. The focus of her current research is to investigate the role of inflammation in aortic stiffening and endothelial function. Her other recent projects have included studies using novel molecular imaging techniques to investigate arterial inflammation. She has authored numerous peer-reviewed articles and has received awards at international conferences for her work.
