



Professor Michael J Mulvany, Aarhus University, Aarhus, Denmark

Michael Mulvany is emeritus professor at the Department of Biomedicine, Aarhus University, where he obtained his PhD (1978) and DMSc (1983) degrees until his retirement as full professor in 2011. His research focuses on the structure and function of small arteries, their role in the development of hypertension and drug treatments to normalize their abnormal structure. From 2003-2010 he headed the Aarhus Graduate School of Health Sciences and was ORPHEUS vice-president from 2010-2014. Awards include the European Society of Microcirculation's Malpighi award (2002) and the BCPT Nordic prize in Basic and Clinical Pharmacology (2013).
