



Professor Andreas Kjær, Professor, University of Copenhagen and Chief Physician, Rigshospitalet, the National University Hospital of Denmark

Andreas Kjaer is professor at the University of Copenhagen and chief physician at Dept. of Clinical Physiology, Nuclear Medicine & PET at Rigshospitalet, the National University Hospital of Denmark. He is president of the SSCPNM national representative of the ESMI, national director of the European Advanced Translational Research Infrastructure in Medicine and editor-in-chief of Diagnostics. His research is focused on molecular imaging with PET and PET/MRI in cancer and cardiovascular disease and his achievements include development of several new tracers that have reached first-in-humans clinical use. He is holder of an ERC Advanced Grant, has published more than 300 peer-review articles, supervised 30 PhD students, co-founded 2 biotech companies and has received numerous prestigious scientific awards over the years. Recently he was appointed member of the Danish Academy of Technical Sciences.
