THE ARTERY SOCIETY

The concept that vascular age is better related to prognosis than chronological age is rapidly evolving. Stiffening of arteries, an important element of vascular ageing, is a potent cardiovascular risk prognosticator and emerges as an appealing therapeutic target. "Premature vascular ageing" is genetically determined but it is also associated with cardiovascular risk factors, such as diabetes and hypercholesterolaemia and is modified by several pharmacological and non-pharmacological means, such as nutritional products and lifestyle habits. Furthermore, significance of central haemodynamics is now appreciated beyond the pathopysiological level to risk determination and therapy. Therefore, methods of assessing arterial stiffness and central haemodynamics are important in the modern management of cardiovascular disease, both in terms of risk assessment and therapeutics.

Conference

The ARTERY Society promotes the advancement of knowledge and dissemination of information concerning the pathophysiology, pharmacology, epidemiology, detection, investigation and treatment of arterial structure and function.

Our annual conference covers fully the expanding list of topics relating to large artery structure and function through keynote lectures, lively debates, presentations of peer-reviewed abstracts and practical demonstrations. The conference offers plenty of opportunities for scientific interaction and discussions with dedicated scientists in the field.


ARTERY EVENTS



Terms & Conditions

The Booking Form constitutes an agreement by the Exhibitor to exhibit at ARTERY 2022 on these terms and conditions only. The Organisers reserve the right to accept or refuse such agreement at its sole discretion.

In the event that the Organisers accept the Exhibitor's offer, the Organiser will provide written confirmation of the booking, and this will create a legally binding contract between the Exhibitor and the Organiser on these terms and conditions only to the exclusion of all others (this 'Agreement').

All bookings of exhibition packages are administered on a first come, first-served basis. Each stand includes complimentary registrations for two exhibition personnel to include access, refreshments at official Conference break times & conference materials. A completed Exhibition Booking Form should be emailed to ensure reservation of a desired location. Upon receipt of the Exhibition Booking Form, space will be confirmed, and an invoice will be mailed. Payment

Cancellation clause

If the Exhibitor cancels this Agreement, the Organiser shall refund (subject to any costs as set out below) to the Exhibitor a percentage of the fees determined in accordance with the following:

- if cancellation/reduction is received between 26 September 2022 and 7 October, the organisers shall retain 80% of the agree package amount
 - and if cancellation/reduction is received after 8 October, the organisers shall retain 100% of the agreed package.
